



SGA GOLF CLUB **COURTESY ROUND**

Prior to the award of a USGA HI, a member of the SGA Golf Club's Handicap Committee will conduct a Courtesy Round to ensure that members:

- a. Posses a reasonable understanding of the rules of golf**
- b. Are aware of the etiquette required during the game**
- c. Posses the required golf skills.**

1. PRE-REQUISITES FOR THE CR

To be eligible for the CR, candidates must have:

- Attended and passed the workshop on golf rules and etiquette.**
- Obtained a Proficiency Certificate.**
- Submitted 10 x 9-hole scorecards or 5 x 18-hole scorecards.**

(Note: The cards submitted must be from courses that meet with USGA Handicap System requirements: i.e. the course must have a USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating, and must be at least 1,350m for 9 holes, or at least 2,700m for 18 holes. Scores from courses that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted)

2. CONDUCT OF THE CR

- The CR will be conducted over 9 holes**
- Turnout: Candidates must show up 15 minutes before the appointed tee-off time. Any appearance after this time will be considered a major fault. Golfing attire is T-shirt with collar, tailored pants, shorts or skirts (for ladies) and golfing shoes.**

- **Rules and etiquette:** Failure to show basic etiquette is considered a major fault. Similarly, failure to demonstrate understanding of a golf rule will be considered a major fault.
- **Golf skills:** Candidates must demonstrate a reasonable ball striking ability.

3. CR QUALIFYING STANDARDS

A candidate with two or more major faults will be deemed to have not met with the qualifying standards of the CR.

4. COST OF A CR

- **Cost a CR is S\$30 plus the green and buggy fees.**
